

Tee Ball Division Rules

Please have players arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of the game.

Games can still be played with a minimum of 6 players or coaches discretion

- Umpires – Coaches will umpire games from the field
 - Fielding Team's coach will call plays made on the bases
 - Be sure to provide a positive experience for the players and call fairly
- Visiting team bats first
- Home team bats second
- Games have 1:00 time limit
 - Time clocks are now provided. Time will start on first pitch of game.
 - Last inning will begin once the visiting team starts to bat with less than 15 minutes remaining
 - Outs will not be recorded. Teams will bat the entire lineup each inning.
 - All players will play in the field.
- No scores are kept
- No stealing and no leading off
- Base Running
 - Runners may advance to second on a ball hit past the fielders without being contacted by the fielders. All runners ahead of the hitter will advance only 2 bases on the same play.
 - No batter can advance more than a double
 - No advancing on errors – We want to encourage kids to make an attempt to make the play, so that they learn where to throw the ball. We don't want kids throwing the ball all over.
- Hitters and base runners must wear batting helmets
- Batters will swing until the ball is put in play
 - All batters are required to use the tee (we want to see good technique)
 - Batted balls only rolling a few feet will be called foul
- Open defensive substitutions/ players can be moved around during an inning.
- Players occupying the pitching position must wear a batting helmet and stand no closer to home plate than the pitching line (Up to 2 players may occupy pitching position, one on the first base side of the pitching line and one on the third base side)
- Mandatory play
 - Outs will not be recorded
 - Teams will bat the entire lineup each inning
 - Teams are encouraged to play all players in the field
- Tee Ball Division games that are rained out will not be made up.
- No end of season tournament

Tee Ball is designed for the introduction of baseball and learning the basics of hitting, throwing, and fielding. Preparing the kids for the next level is the goal.
