- 2. Consideration of Resolution 2018-1 requesting a property tax levy allocation of \$100,436 from the Norfolk City Council, a 10.5% increase from the prior year (see attached resolution and budget reflecting this request.) Update on Façade and Signage improvement grants awarded Stappert motioned for consideration of resolution 2018-1, Porn seconded. Roll call: all yays, no nays motion carried.
- 3. Consideration or purchasing benches for 4<sup>th</sup> street on trees, plantings, and cutouts on 4<sup>th</sup> street. Connie said the benches would cost around \$1800.00. The board would like to continue this discussion at the next meeting.
- 4. Update on public artwork options for 4<sup>th</sup> street Connie said the artwork would cost \$1850 for the frames and \$1850 for the Vinyl's that go in the frames. Blackman asked if the board should ask any local businesses to help purchase the art. Love suggested we table the discussion until the full board is present.
- 5. Consideration of legal description from JEO Geary said the board previously approved the annexation request of the property on the north side of Braasch Ave. This agenda item is to approve the legal description of the property from JEO with the exclusion of Black Hills Energy's property.

Porn motioned to approve the annexation of the property as shown by the legal description provided by JEO. Love seconded. Roll call: all yays, no nays, motion carried.

- 6. Consideration of Warrick Tire request for tree trimming at 716 W. Norfolk Ave. Geary said there was a request from Warrick Tire for a tree to be trimmed away from their roof. The board discussed that Fischer tree service will be in the area spraying for bagworms, so they would like a estimate of what trees need trimming and prices. Porn motioned to get an estimate, Love seconded, roll call: all yays, no nays, motion carried.
- 7. Update of River Point Fork Fest on July 20, 2018. Porn gave a general update of the event and reminded business owners to submit specials and events to her for updating the website. The event will consist of live music, food trucks, downtown sidewalk sales, a car show, a kayak event, and a .5k run/walk.
