### Braasch Reconstruction Project to Begin May 18, 2020

Braasch Avenue from 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street will be closed on May 18, 2020 as part of the Braasch Avenue Reconstruction Project. This closure is expected to last approximately 3 months. North and South traffic on 1<sup>st</sup> Street will be maintained throughout the project, but may be reduced to one lane in each direction during portions of the project. The project will be broken into three phases, all of which include utility, paving and landscaping work. The project stems from a Department of Economic Development Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) awarded to the City of Norfolk.

Access to properties along Braasch Avenue will be maintained throughout the project. Future phases of the project include Braasch Avenue from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and 4<sup>th</sup> Street from Braasch Avenue to the railroad tracks. More details will be provided for future closures as construction progresses.
