

## INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Proposals for the construction of Benjamin Avenue from 13th Street to 1st Street for the City of Norfolk, Schemmer Project No. 7542.001, will be received by the City Clerk at 309 N 5th Street, Norfolk, NE 68701, until 10:30 a.m. on the 17th day of February 2022, and thereafter will be read aloud.

The work is generally described as follows: Improvements include approximately 36,000 SY of removals and 43,000 SY of pavement. 5200 linear feet of RCP storm sewer and 60 storm inlets with associated laterals, a box culvert extension, 1200 square feet of modular block retaining wall, 31 street lighting fixtures with associated conduit and enhanced landscaping elements including trees, shrubs, hardscape and pedestrian lighting. Temporary and permanent traffic control are also included with the project.

A non-mandatory (encouraged) pre-bid conference will be held at:

Proposals will be taken for said construction work listed above by unit prices, as an aggregate bid for the entire project.

All Proposals for said construction work must be made on blanks furnished by the Engineer and must be accompanied by Bid Security of not less than 5% of the amount bid. Bid Security to be made payable to the Treasurer of the City of Norfolk as liquidated damages in case the bid is accepted and the bidder neglects or refuses, to enter into contract and furnish bond in accordance herewith.

Copies of the contract documents are on file with the City of Norfolk for examination by bidders. Complete digital project bidding documents are available through A&D Technical Supply website. To bid the project, the contract documents must be issued directly by A&D Technical Supply.
