

Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids will be received in the City offices, 309 North 5th Street, Norfolk, Nebraska, until 11:00 a.m. on the 31st day of October, 2017 to furnish all labor, materials, use of contractor's equipment, plant, and all else necessary to properly construct all of the improvements for the project:

Victory Road Trail 2017-1

at which hour, or as soon as possible thereafter, the bids will be opened, read aloud, and tabulated, in the presence of all attending bidders to furnish said labor, materials, and equipment broken down to accurately reflect unit prices for all estimated quantities.

The work consists of construction of 3636 S.Y. of an 8' and 10' wide concrete trail on the west side of North Victory Road. Trail also consists of removing 717 S.Y. of sidewalk and driveways, installation of 54 L.F. of 15" to 24" RCP, subgrade preparation, borrowed fill, vegetation removal, placement of 632 L.F. of 7' wide 6" depth concrete liner with crushed concrete and fabric, and all other necessary items for construction.


All work called for in the plans and specifications shall be furnished in strict accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department of the City of Norfolk, and bids will be received only upon the forms furnished by the City.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check on a bank whose deposits are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in the amount of 5% of the total bid price and must be payable without condition to the Treasurer, City of Norfolk, Nebraska, as evidence of good faith of the bidder and as agreed liquidated damages in case the bidder whose proposal is accepted by the City of Norfolk fails to enter into contract within ten (10) days from the Notice of the Award or fails to furnish acceptable bond to complete the work and pay for all labor and materials used, said bond to be in the amount of 100% of the total bid price.

Plans and specifications and contract documents may be examined and procured from the Engineering Division Office at 309 North 5th Street, Norfolk, Nebraska, 68701, upon the payment of \$50.00 which will not be refunded.

The City of Norfolk, Nebraska, reserves the right to waive informalities and to reject any or all bids.
