CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT
RESOLUTION NO. 2005PC-12

WHEREAS, The Salvation Army has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit seeking a recycling operation on property which is legally described as follows:

Lot 2, Block 3, Golden Spike Addition-Phase III, a Subdivision in the City of Norfolk, Madison County, Nebraska

WHEREAS, the property described above is presently included in Zoning District C-2; and

WHEREAS, the Norfolk Planning Commission has conducted a public hearing on November 22, 2005 receiving input and data from the applicant and the general public concerning the Conditional Use Permit;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, the Planning Commission of the City of Norfolk, Nebraska hereby adopts the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Norfolk Planning Commission of the City of Norfolk, Nebraska that The Salvation Army is hereby granted a Conditional Use Permit for a recycling operation subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The surrounding parking lot and neighborhood shall be kept free of debris and garbage;
2. A site plan showing the placement of the collection containers, processed and unprocessed materials shall be attached to this permit;
3. There shall be compliance with any other applicable City, County, State or Federal regulations that may apply;
4. Pursuant to the Norfolk City Code, this Conditional Use Permit shall be a personal privilege granted to the applicant and shall not be subject to transfer; and
5. The Conditional Use Permit granted herein shall be subject to the provisions of the Norfolk City Code that provide for an appeal to be taken within 15 days of the decision of the Planning Commission.
