WHEREAS, the Norfolk Planning Commission of the City of Norfolk adopted Conditional Use Permit Resolution No. 2011PC-3 at its May 17, 2011 meeting which Resolution granted a Conditional Use Permit for storage of concrete, asphalt and bricks east of Victory Road and Eisenhower Avenue more particularly described as follows:

SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 12, Township 24 North, Range 1 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Madison County, Nebraska

WHEREAS, said Conditional Use Permit granted by Resolution No. 2011PC-3 is no longer necessary as the property's zoning district changed to I-1 where storage of concrete, asphalt and bricks is a permitted use;
