CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT RESOLUTION NO. 2020PC-2

- Failure to observe and maintain the conditions and restrictions of the conditional use permit shall be considered a violation of the Norfolk City Code subject to penalty as provided herein and may be grounds for review of the permit;

- 4. All procedures and standards outlined in Section 27-56 of the Norfolk City Code pertaining to Conditional Use Permits shall be observed and the Conditional Use Permit granted herein shall be subject to the provisions of the Norfolk City Code that provide for an appeal to be taken within fifteen (15) days of the decision of the Planning Commission, and;
- 5. There shall be compliance with any other applicable City, County, State, or Federal regulations that may apply.
