- No storage of parts, dismantled motor vehicles, etc., may be stored outside the building;
- All refuse shall be kept in covered containers and screened from view;
- No dismantling of truck tractors shall occur outside the building;
- The property shall be mowed, maintained, and kept free of weeds and debris;
- All waste oils or other wastes resulting from truck repair shall be properly

disposed of;

- The Conditional Use Permit shall be for twenty (20) years and issued to RDO Truck Center Co.;
- Failure to observe and maintain the conditions and restrictions of the conditional use permit shall be considered a violation of The Code of the City of Norfolk, Nebraska subject to penalty as provided herein and may be grounds for review of the permit;
- 8. All procedures and standards outlined in Section 27-56 of the Norfolk City Code pertaining to Conditional Use Permits shall be observed and the Conditional Use Permit granted herein shall be subject to the provisions of the Norfolk City Code that provide for an appeal to be taken within 15 days of the decision of the Planning Commission, and;
- There shall be compliance with any other applicable City, County, State, or Federal regulations that may apply.
