PUBLIC HEARING

Public hearing to amend section 6-52 of the official city code to adopt the 2014 national electrical code; to amend section 6-71 to add "installer" to the list of types of licenses required in order to do electrical work; to amend section 6-76 to require a homeowner to live in his or her house at the time he or she does their own electrical work to their house; to amend section 6-78 to make a clarification with regard to electrical contractors; to amend section 6-79 to delete unnecessary language related to registration periods.

Chair Snodgrass opened the hearing at 7:32 a.m. and asked Trent for an explanation of this ordinance.

An earlier ordinance was passed by the commission approving the 2011 code but was never addressed by the city council. After the planning commission hearing, a memo was received indicating the state legislature had passed a bill, with an emergency clause, immediately

approving the 2014 electrical code. This amendment was brought back to the commission and when passed, will approve the 2014 electrical code and other state guidelines.

Chair Snodgrass closed the hearing at 7:34 a.m. for discussion and action.

Commissioner Lundy moved and Marsh seconded to approve the amendment to the official city code reference the national electrical code.
