

TO USE THE ACCUCUT

- The blocks are called “dies.” Each die has a letter, shape, or pattern on it. Choose the one you want to use.
- Place it in the tray with the rubber side up.
- Place your paper on top of the rubber side of the die.
- Use the handle to roll the die and paper under the roller.
- Your design will be cut out as it goes under the roller and can be taken out on the other side.

MATERIALS YOU CAN CUT WITH THE ACCUCUT

A good rule of thumb is that if a material can be cut with household scissors, then it can be cut with the AccuCut.
